




**Two Ways to Live:  
The Choice We All Have**







**The Bible states that there are only two ways of life: “under law” and “under grace.”**




**Everyone born into the world is born under the law of God and its demand for perfection.**




**Because of our fallen nature, the law of God actually provokes us to sin against God.**




**And unless we are saved, we will be judged by the law.**






....Then another book

## But now a righteousness apart from the law is offered to us.




**Those who believe Christ bore the penalty of our sin by His death and was raised again for our justification will not be judged by the law.**
