### **General Indicatives**

Man's sin and resulting separation from God

God provided a way of reconciliation through Christ's death on the cross

Salvation is by grace alone through faith alone by Christ alone.

# Personal Imperatives

Recognize your inherent sinfulness and failure to meet God's standards

Realize that salvation is a gift by God's grace alone and that Jesus is the only way to God

Repent and believe in Jesus Christ's atoning sacrifice for your sins (reflecting a desire to obey and please Him.)

## **General Indicatives**

Christians are new creatures in Christ with changed hearts but will still battle sin at times.

God's will is for Christians to grow and mature in their faith.

God's fatherly love includes discipline; He desires His children's faith to grow through the testing He allows.

## Personal Imperatives

Repent after sinning to restore fellowship with God.

Read and obey Scriptures that urge holy behavior; love and live by the law of liberty

Submit to God's sovereign will for your life; trust and obey in the midst of trials and testing of your faith.
